Objectives of Professional Unit 2017-18:

- 1. Ongoing work with developing and maintaining UNIMARC format is a part of **Strategic Direction 2. Information & Knowledge.** The primary purpose of UNIMARC is to facilitate the international exchange of bibliographic data between bibliographic agencies or libraries. UNIMARC is also used as a model for developing new machine-readable bibliographic formats. Both purposes of UNIMARC formats are closely linked to the IFLA strategic plan to support access to information and knowledge anywhere in the world.
- 2. The online edition of UNIMARC formats will allow UNIMARC users to easily and efficiently follow news, additions and corrections in all UNIMARC formats as part of IFLA's initiative on **1.4 Promoting IFLA standards to support libraries in the provision of services to their communities.**
- 3. UNIMARC as linked data project is also part of IFLA's key 2.1. Defining a long-term, sustainable information environment.
- 4. UNIMARC User's Group Meeting for Western Asia Region is part of **Strategic direction 4. Capacity Building.** UNIMARC User's Group Meeting will support Iranian National Library in its regional task to build the skills in libraries for using standardised digital format codes.
- 5. The communication protocol between RDA Steering Committee (RSC) and IFLA Permanent UNIMARC Committee is part of the ongoing process of the harmonization of UNIMARC formats with Library Reference Model and worldwide accepted guidelines, and instructions for creating a library and cultural heritage resource metadata. This project is part of IFLA's key **2.1. Defining a long-term, sustainable information environment.**
